CAMP:

Camp is a huge flat area with plenty of room for large trailers. Horse water available, all dogs MUST be on leash. Camp is open Friday - Sunday.

CAMPING FEES:

\$12/unit per night.

Additional vehicles - \$10/night

Day Use: A discover pass is required for hauling in and out the same day. No pass is required if you are paying for camping. You can purchase this online [here](#) or you can purchase at camp. Annual pass is \$35, one day pass is \$11.50

TRAILS:

You will enjoy beautiful trails offering up some amazing views of Spokane. There will be trails along the river, some climbing, and meandering through single track trail. This is a multi-use area so you may encounter hikers and/or bicyclists. All vet checks are in camp. The trail will be well marked and ride with GPS tracks available. Hoof protection is encouraged.

INTRO RIDE:

The intro ride is 13 miles of incredible trail of various terrain. Perfect for a young horse or someone who would like to try endurance.

PRIZE RIDE:

Enjoy a beautiful ride of about 10 miles of stunning family friendly trails. 1st place is \$300, 2nd is \$200 and 3rd \$100

ENTRY FEES:

- Prize/Intro \$40
- 25 mile: \$120
- 50 mile: \$130
- \$20 Non AERC Member fee
- \$5 discount for PNER members
- All endurance riders under the age of 18 ride free 50% Reciprocal Ride manager discount

- From the east or the west: (Note: If you are coming from the east, GPS will take you all the way through downtown, it is easier with a trailer to follow the directions shown below.)

Directions: I-90 to US-2W (Exit 277B)

Turn R on Flint Rd

Turn R on W Trails Rd

L on N Old Trails Rd

R on W 7 Mile Rd

R on Riverside Park

R into park.
