
## Saturday July 27, 2019 35,55,75 & Trail Ride

**Trail:** Forested trails and old dirt roads, some rock but no mountains to climb. Our Trail Ride is an opportunity to learn more about our sport by following a ribbon-ed trail.

Ride Camp: Held at Lily Glen Horse Camp. Entry covers camping in group A & B Group Camp. Limited corrals but ample parking in a meadow with trees along the perimeter. Stallions must be double tied. Electric fencing is not recommended. ODF requires all vehicles to cool down before

Ride Meeting: Head Vet DVM Ferguson.7pm Friday, bring your Trail Map to the meeting. Saturday night potluck, we provide an entree and garlic bread, please bring a side salad or desert. Awards to follow.

From Central Oregon: Take Hwy 97 south, turn right onto Hwy 138, turn left onto Hwy 62, (Medford), take Hwy 140 to F.S. Rd. 37, (approx 27 plus miles), turn right onto F.S. Rd. 37 follow it to Dead Indian Memorial Rd. turn right toward Ashland, follow signs to camp, look for camp on the left.

From Klamath Falls: Take Hwy 66 to Clover Creek Rd. (before Keno) turn right and proceed to Dead Indian Memorial Rd. Turn left and continue to Lily Glen on your left.

From I-5 Medford: Exit I-5 at Hwy 62, drive east to Hwy 140, turn right and follow to F.S. Rd 37. Turn right and stay on this to Dead Indian Memorial Rd. Turn right continue for about 4 miles, Lily Glen Horse Camp will be on your left.

From Ashland: Steeper route. Take exit 14, turn east toward Klamath Falls on Hwy 66 for one half mile, then turn left onto Dead Indian Memorial Rd. Continue for approximately 18 plus miles to Lily Glen Horse Camp, turn right into camp.
