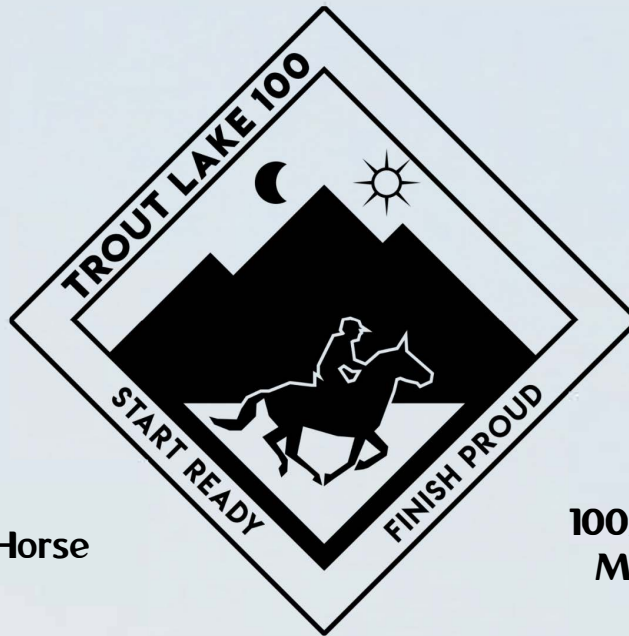

LOCATION:

Adjacent to the Mt Adams Horse
Camp in Trout Lake, WA

**100/50/75/25/12 & TYM 100
Mile Relay and Ride & Tie**

DIRECTIONS:

From Oregon I-84:

- From I-84, exit b4 in Hood River
- Cross the Hood River Bridge over Columbia River towards White Salmon, WA.
- West on Hwy 14, ~1 mile
- North on Alt Hwy 141, ~4 miles
- Continue north on Hwy 141, ~20 miles to Trout Lake.
- In Trout Lake, bear right at Andy's Service Station/Cafe, follow the ribbons and signs to ride camp.

From Washington (from the north):

Follow the same directions as from Oregon.
(i.e. I-5 South to I-84)

DO NOT COME VIA FS23 THROUGH RANDLE, WA!

RIDE CAMP: Free if in field adjacent to the Mt Adams Horse Camp. If you choose to use the designated sites in the horse camp, you must pay the nightly USFS fee.

TRAIL: Forest Service roads and single-track trails with moderate elevation change.

RULES:

- EDRA Rules apply.
- Helmets required for riders, whenever mounted.
- All dogs must be leashed/kenneled.
- PNER rules & points apply.
- Hoof protection is required.
- Ride a Tie Assoc. rules apply.

USFS requires manure removal.

- Midnight Riders 4-H Club offers removal with a recommended \$20 per horse donation, or
- You may pack your manure home. Trash bags available.

USFS requires Certified Weed Seed Free Hay.
