OWYHEE TRAILS 4 DAY TRAIL RIDE – Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday, (ApHC Regional Ride- open to ALL breeds) A different self-guided loop of 5 -19 miles each day from same ride camp, flexible start times. \$35 a day or all 4 - \$125 no meals provided, hoodies if u enter all 4 days!! COMPETITIVE TRAIL RIDE 25 miles Sunday May 12 7:30 AM, AHA Rules apply not NATRC.

25-55-mile AERC/PNER endurance ride- Check in May 10, last day to enter and vet in. Ride meeting -- 7 PM May 10. May 11 - 55-mile AERC/PNER (6:30 AM) and a 25-mile LD (7:30 AM);25 's have a 15-mile loop out to Coyote Springs, vet check in camp, and a 10-mile loop through Succor Creek canyon. 55's will have two loops with vetting in camp. Hoody for Completion, BC, First, Top 10 & FUN awards! Bring a dish to share for the Potluck dinner, raffle & awards Saturday after all finish. Ride 4 days of any activity to get a special award!! ENTRIES -25/55 AERC/PNER Discounted Entry Fee: \$95 /\$75 Jr or rider over 70 if PAID by April 20. Ask for RM Discount. After 4/20 ALL 25/55 entries are \$105; NO discounts & entries close May 10. CTR \$80 Sr/ \$60 for Juniors and riders over 70 if pre-enter by April 20 or \$90; after April 20 no discounts. Entry deadline in May 9.

This is a no frills campground. Porta potties & Horse water hauled in. If you use any type of portable corral no more than two horses per separate pen. If you use electric your unit needs a proper ground, it must be on when occupied, must be 3 ft tall and have 2 strands of visible tape. No exceptions, we want to be safe.

Camp: Take Hwy 201 South from Nyssa, OR to Adrian, OR, continue on 201 turn right or south onto Succor Creek Rd - sign says Succor Creek State Park - go 4 miles to ride camp. Or take Hwy 19 west from Homedale, across Stateline this becomes OR Hwy 201, turn left (south) onto Succor Creek Rd, 1.9miles west of Stateline. Gas, tires and groceries available in both Homedale and Nyssa. Café, Welding shop and hardware only available in Adrian. There is gas/groceries and a grill at Owyhee Junction on Hwy 201.
